

Undergraduate Academic Standing Review Timeline and Process Spring 2026

Date	Process Explained
4/15/26	<p>Please check the academic calendar for campus deadlines for course withdrawals, pass/fail applications, and withdrawal from college.</p> <p>Official academic standing notices will be sent to your Buffalo State email addresses by June 1, 2026. Failing to check your email will <u>not</u> result in an extension of the academic standing review deadlines.</p>
5/20/26	The final grading window closes for Faculty.
5/22/26	Semester grades will be available in Banner for Academic Standing Review.
6/01/26	<p>The Director of Academic Standards will send dismissal notices via email, and hard copies will be mailed via U.S. Mail.</p> <p>The deadline to submit a dismissal appeal is June 12, 2026, at 3:00 p.m.</p> <p>If you are enrolled in summer sessions (ES or VS) they will be administratively dropped. Students' fall registration <u>will not be</u> administratively altered until the end of the dismissal appeal period (Provost appeal on 6/26/26).</p>
6/02/26 – 6/12/26	Probationary status notices and Letters of Concern will be sent
6/12/26	Dismissal appeal deadline.
6/17/26	The Director of Academic Standards will email the dismissal appeal outcome letters to all students' Buffalo State email accounts.
6/17-25/26	<p>Provost-level Appeal begins (6/17-6/25)</p> <p>Eligible only for those whom the Dismissal Appeals Board denied. Students must notify Mrs. Ann Delmont or Mrs. Sandra Flanigan in writing of their appeal request and justify it.</p> <p>The deadline is 3:00 p.m. (e.g., new documentation that was not provided to the Dismissal Appeals Board).</p>
6/26/26	Provost-level appeal decisions will be sent to students via their Buffalo State email.
06/30/26	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Fall 2026 classes and room/board charges dropped for dismissed students. ▪ Students who are unsuccessful in their appeal and reside on campus must submit a request to terminate their housing license.

Dismissal Notification Procedures

Students will be notified of their academic dismissal via their Buffalo State email account. Hard copies of dismissal notices will also be sent to students' permanent addresses listed in Banner. Students should regularly check their campus email addresses to maximize their time to prepare their dismissal appeal or make alternate plans for the following semester.

Registration for the Following Semester

Dismissed students are NOT permitted to be enrolled in J-Term or Summer courses at Buffalo State. The university will cancel all registrations, housing contracts, and meal plans unless students successfully appeal their dismissal decision. Therefore, in this case, Spring/Fall registrations, housing contracts, and meal plans will be retained until a decision has been made.
